

POSITION: NETWORKER FOR PEACE, SOCIAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS (PSEC)

APPOINTED BY: NPYM Steering Committee
APPOINTED AT: Second Annual Session Steering Committee Meeting
NOMINATED BY: NPYM Nominating Committee
TERM BEGINS: October 1
TERM LENGTH: Two years, renewable

WORKS PRIMARILY WITH: Clerks of PSEC committees and/or other contacts from each Monthly Meeting and Worship Group. May establish contact with designated Friends' national or regional organizations, such as Friends in Unity with Nature or the regional AFSC offices (Seattle and Portland). May make list available to isolated Friends and other members and attenders of constituent Meetings who request it. Works with Yearly Meeting Directory Coordinator to minimize duplication of effort.

DEFINITION: Works to establish, circulate and update a directory of Meeting and Worship Group contacts, with names, email, telephone, fax, mailing addresses and terms of office. Facilitates communication to exchange and expand concerns, insights and social concerns activities within NPYM.

TASKS & TIMELINE:

During the first six months

Assemble and distribute names, addresses, etc., as indicated above. Help these contacts to understand the purpose and potential of this list. Distribute also to those isolated Friends who might request the list, and to Steering Committee members.

Annually thereafter

Contact Meetings and Worship Groups to update the list, and then redistribute it.

Report on activities to Steering Committee.

EVALUATION: Prepare a report/evaluation for the Networker files at end of term. This report should include information useful to the next Networker (what worked, what didn't) and any changes you think should be made in the job or the job description.

EXPENSES AND TRAVEL: Reimbursement is provided for "office expense" (LD phone calls, postage and photocopy) and mileage expense for these responsibilities. Submit reimbursement request with receipts to NPYM Treasurer.
