Awards are intended to be partial scholarships and generally will not exceed \$500.00. Priority will be given to new applicants before those who have received help from the Fund in the past.

Grants from the Youth Opportunity Fund are disbursed three times a year. Applications must be *postmarked* by the due date.

Winter applications are due on March 1, with awards made by March 15.

Spring applications are due on May 1, with awards made by May 15.

Fall applications are due on October 1, with awards made by October 15.
